## Supplementary Regulations

1. The Classic and Modern Motorsport Club will organise an Interclub Permit Race Meeting at Mallory Park, Leicestershire, LE9 7QE on Saturday & Sunday, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> May 2026.
2. The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit (Interclub) has been applied for. This event is open to foreign participation; NCR Ch6 App3.1.6 and FIA ISC Article 2.3.7b applies.
4. The meeting is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club, to members of the AMOC, BARC, BRSCC, MGCC, CSCC, TR Register, Bentley Drivers Club, 500 Owners Association, MGO, Jaguar Enthusiasts Club, 750 MC, VSCC, and Morgan Sports Car Club; see NCR Ch6 App3.1.1.10/1.1.11
5. Rounds of the following Championships will take place:
  - BRSCC Classic 2CV Racing Club Championship
  - BRSCC Hickford Construction MG Metro Championship
  - 5000A Circuit Racing Championship
  - Northern Saloon & Sports Car Championship
  - FJHRA Historic Formula Junior Championship
6. Competitors must hold Motorsport UK racing licences of Interclub or higher grade and (if applicable) Club membership cards. Pre-event Signing-on will take place.
7. The Circuit is Mallory Park, Leicestershire, LE9 7QE and is 1.35 miles (2.17km) in length. Racing will be in a clockwise direction.
8. Scrutineering will take place in accordance with Motorsport UK regulations on the day and with individual Championship and Series Regulations. The noise limit for competing cars is 105dB(A).
9. The Races, Classes and Awards (**NOT IN TIMETABLE ORDER**):

2 x 20-minute scratch races ( 2 x 10 minutes qualifying) for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.

  - BRSCC Hickford Construction MG Metro Championship**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Series Regulations.  
Classes as specified in Series Regulations.

  - FJHRA Formula Junior Championship**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races (20 minute qualifying) for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.  
Classes as specified in Championship Regulations.

  - Northern Saloon & Sports Car Championship**  
2 x 15-minute (plus 1 lap) scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.  
Classes as specified in Championship Regulations.

  - 5000A Circuit Racing Championship**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.  
Classes as specified in Championship Regulations.

  - MMCS Production Saloon Series (Saturday only)**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Series Regulations.  
Classes are as specified in Series Regulations.

  - MMCS Super Saloons Series (Saturday only)**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Series Regulations.  
Classes are as specified in Series Regulations.

  - MMCS Intermarque Silhouette Series (Sunday only)**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Series Regulations.  
Classes are as specified in Series Regulations.

  - Hadfield Motorsport Trophy (Sunday only)**  
2 x 15-minute scratch races for Pumas/Fiestas.  
Classes are as specified by Organiser.  
**Awards:** As specified by Organiser

### **Mallory 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Race (Sunday only)**

2 x 15-minute scratch races for 1950's and 1960's cars (Sports cars/saloon cars).

Classes will be dependent upon entries .

**Awards:** First, second and third in each race

**All entries will receive a complementally plaque.**

**In the event the race is oversubscribed then preference will be given to cars that actually raced in period at Mallory.**

### **EXTRA TRACK SESSIONS**

On Sunday morning there will be two track sessions of 15 minutes, one open to Closed wheeled vehicles, already entered in the meeting and the other will be for Open wheeled vehicles already entered in the meeting. Cost will be £80. Full details will be given in Final Instructions.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and **closes finally on Friday 15th May 2024**. Entries may be considered after this date but only if accompanied by an **additional £30**. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER WEDNESDAY 20<sup>th</sup> May**.

**All Race Entry Fees are via the relevant Championship/Series race organisers, except the 50's/60's race which costs £250 and completion of entry form which has to be sent to CMMC, 97 Heather Shaw, Trowbridge Wiltshire BA14 7JT or e-mailed to [UKMotorsport@aol.com](mailto:UKMotorsport@aol.com)**

All entries must be made on an official form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Electronic entries can be made in line with individual organiser's procedures. To save administration time and costs, entries will be acknowledged by e-mail whenever possible. Please include your e-mail address on the entry form.

Entries will be selected in line with NCR Ch6 App1.10.1/10.3; i) Registered Championship/Series contenders first and ii) entry forms received in chronological order. In the event of over subscription, a reserve list of up to 30% of the grid will be accepted based on the receipt of the entry forms.

Entry fees will also be returned if a competitor notifies the organiser in writing or email by 5.00pm on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2025 that they wish to withdraw their entry. **There will be NO REFUNDS after this cut-off date**. An administration fee of £25.00 will be deducted. 11. The maximum number of starters in each race will be 30 (24 sports racers/single seaters) and the minimum will be 20. The minimum number of entries in each class will be 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right either to cancel the meeting, the race or amalgamate qualifying, races or classes or substitute races as appropriate.

12. Senior Officials will be listed in the Competitors' Final Instructions.
13. For each of the races a 15-minute minimum qualifying session will take place, unless as stated in races above. Some practice sessions may be amalgamated or added at the organiser's discretion. Details of these will be published in Competitors' Instructions. Grid positions will be determined by times recorded in official practice/race finish order or as per relevant championship/series regulations.
14. All other National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK apply as written.
15. The starting signal for all races will be given by lights. In the event of any starting lights failure the Starter will use the national flag. Individual races starting procedure will be confirmed in the Competitors' Instructions.
16. Provisional timings/results will be announced as soon as possible after each session/race. Entrants are reminded that any appeal or protest should be made in accordance with Motorsport UK NCR Ch2 App4 and Ch2 App9.
17. Fuel supplies will be available at the circuit.
18. Admission per standard entry will be 4 Personnel passes and 2 Paddock Car Park labels (if issued). No animals are allowed.
19. It is a competitor's responsibility to ensure that he/she completes the requisite number of laps. After receiving the end of race or practice signal cars will complete a full slowing down lap and leave the Circuit as directed by the marshals.
20. Judges of Fact (NCR Ch5 App21) will be named for: False Starts, Technical, Timing, Flag Infringements and Track Limits.
21. Race engines must not be run before 9.15 am or after 18.00. Competitors not complying with this may be excluded.
22. Transponders will be required at this meeting as NCR Ch12 App6 2.2. Please make sure your transponder number is clearly written on your entry form.
23. In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of the Meeting, the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.
